Harold (Hal) Haering, DMD graduated from the University of Kentucky College of Dentistry in 1981. Starting his own family practice after serving as a Commissioned Officer in the USPHS, Hal practiced for 27 years in LaBelle, FL. Hal has served on various dental boards including the Lee County Dental Society and as President of the West Coast District Dental Association. Hal was elected as a Trustee to the Florida Dental Association, and a delegate to the American Dental Association.

Dr. Haering was appointed in 2000 by Governor Jeb Bush to the Florida Board of Dentistry, where he served as Chair of the Board of Dentistry, as well as Chair of both the Rules and Exam Committees. Dr. Haering continued to serve on the Florida Board of Dentistry Probable Cause Panel through 2008. Dr. Haering has served as an expert witness in Administrative Hearings for the Florida Department of Health and Florida Board of Dentistry, as well as serving as an expert witness in civil litigation trials involving dentistry. Hal was appointed to two ADA Councils: The Council on Access, Prevention and Professional Relations (2000-2003), and the Council on Education and Licensure (2005-2009). Beginning in 2006, Dr. Haering was involved with the founding of the American Board of Dental Examiners (ADEX). Following the sale of his practice in 2008, Hal accepted an appointment in 2010 to Nova University College of Dental Medicine as an Assistant Professor, serving as a course director and a clinical instructor. Dr. Haering accepted an appointment as an assistant clinical professor in May 2011 to Midwestern College of Dental Medicine, ARIZONA, and in April 2015, he was appointed to Associate Dean for Clinical Education. As Clinical Dean, he is responsible for the busiest pre-doctoral dental school clinic in the country. Dr. Haering also serves the Council on Dental Accreditation (CODA) as a clinical site visitor to dental programs seeking accreditation.
